

# Scotland 2050

The thing I would like to see is Environmental Clerks of Works (ECoWs) embedded in NPF4 so that ECoWs are standard practice at construction sites where significant risk to the environment exists. To achieve this, the ECoW role needs to be clarified, so it is appropriately commissioned and implemented - this will afford it the autonomy it requires to make the role effective, which is currently lacking.

I would like to see this because this will significantly reduce the high levels of non-compliance and resulting environmental adverse impacts during construction that occur. It will drive up environmental standards during construction; increase compliance within the construction industry, which will better protect the identity of our natural environment and contribute to better health and wellbeing for everyone in our society.
