Letter of support for the Scottish Government's National Planning Framework: Carbon Capture Utilisation and Storage

We have noted the Scottish Government proposal to establish a Carbon Capture Utilisation and Storage (CCUS) Network to support industrial decarbonisation, thermal generation and the production and transmission of large scale low-carbon and renewable hydrogen.


CCUS is central to our ability to respond to the global climate emergency and limit the scale of impact to climate change. Indeed, advice from the CCC describes CCUS as a "necessity, not an option" to achieve net zero emissions.

A CCUS network will provide opportunities for optionality in decarbonising the energy system. A network of CCS and Hydrogen infrastructure enables options to produce, use and export hydrogen for energy and heat
