- connection from CX to national gas transmission network
- infrastructure to collect and connect on shore /offshore wind power (constrained and consented but not built due to constraints) for production of H2/ NH3 on site
- connection from CX to Cumbria via cable/pipeline crossing Solway firth for import/export H2/ wind power
- Highway improvement between CX site and A74(M)/part of the TEN T European Transport Network as current ask within CX SOBC(Borderlands) and site and A75
- re establish rail link to Chapelcross site to handle bulk

support the creation of zero carbon fuel network for key transport modes (hydrogen/ammonia)
