- Transport/active travel hub at car park – masterplan/visitor shuttle bus/e-bikes/electric charging
 - Launch/exit point for kayakers using river
 - Main street requires improvement
 - Wetland being considered south of river to connect with wildlife site
 - Develop renewable energy, enhance and secure public services
